INFRASTRUCTURE

Central Academy Teacher's Training College has sprawling campus of 9999.0 square yard area, which includes constructed and open area. Total rooms are 28. In which there are 18 classrooms, and various offices, common rooms, sports rooms, laboratories etc. are included. The multipurpose hall is equipped with LCD projector, which has suitable seating arrangements for 400 students. The campus is completely green, airy, full of natural light.

 - Biology Lab- It has a collection of different types of biological specimen, Slides, Microscopes, chemicals and charts and models.
2. **Psychology Labs:** It has 15 types of Apparatus with 30 test papers and tools. Every year psychological training and analysis is conducted according to syllabus of B.Ed.& M.Ed.
3. **ICT Lab:** College has 46 computers with Internet Connection with a ICT lab.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT

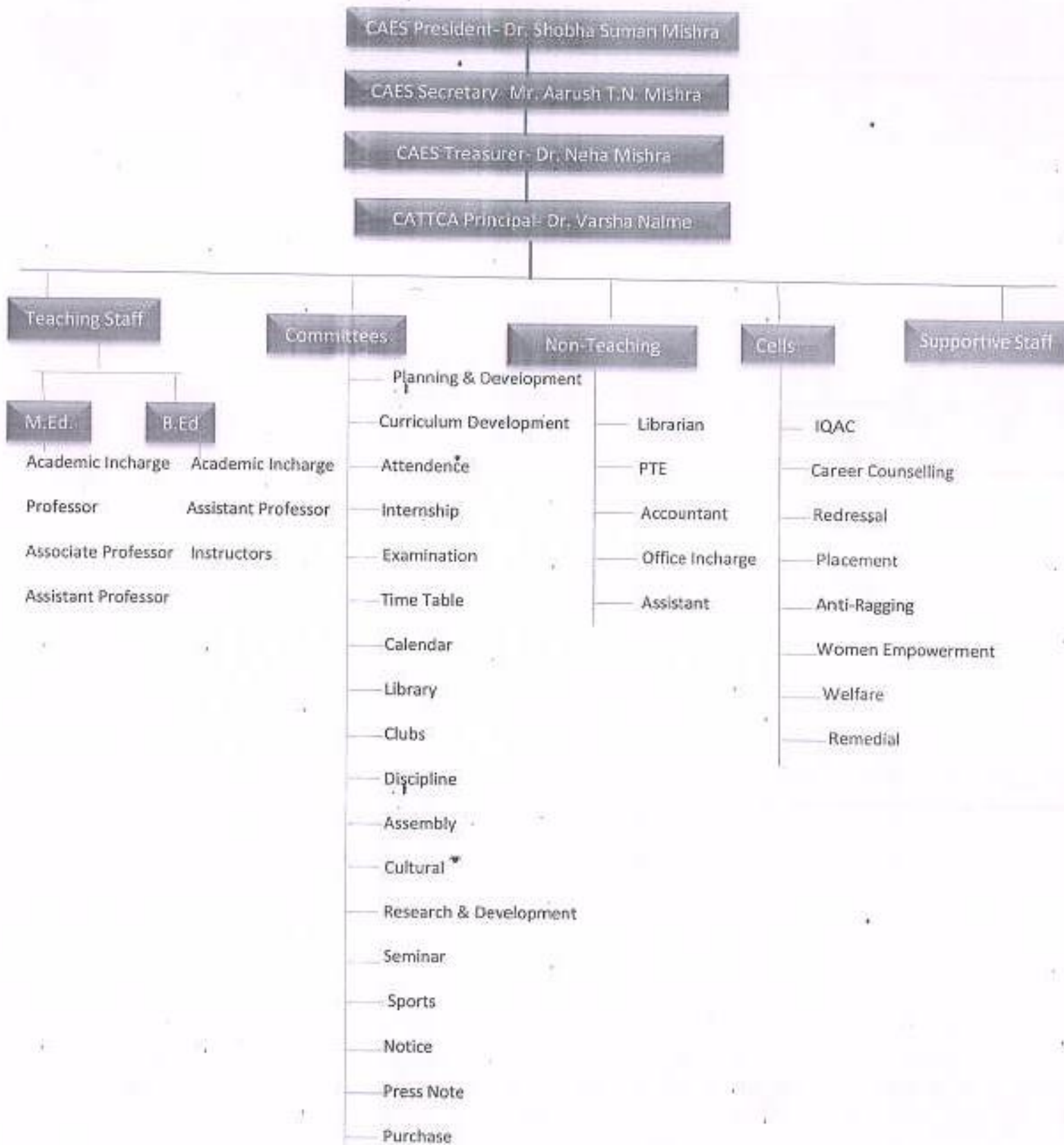
Facility is provided for Indoor and Outdoor games.

PLACEMENT CELL

All through the year employment related advertisement is displayed on the notice board. Various schools are called to conduct campus for placement of B.Ed. students. For the appointment of faculty of B.Ed. colleges, B.Ed. college management is invited for interview so that our M.Ed. students can be provided employment in B.Ed. college, interview and mock interview can be conducted by school and college.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Session start: - B.Ed. first year started on 16th December 2021. On 17th to 18th December 2021, the syllabus of B.Ed. first year session teaching subjects was introduced online.

Orientation Program: - Orientation program was organized from 15 to 18 January 2021. Orientation program in M Ed was conducted from 1st February to 6th February in first and second year.

Micro Teaching: In the first year of B.Ed. micro teaching was conducted from 1st to 6th February for efficiency in teaching skills.

Internal Assessment: - B.Ed. first year unit tests were conducted from 22 October to 29 October 2021 and unit tests for internal assessment in the second year were conducted from 10 March to 20 March 2021. The first unit test of M. Ed first and second year was conducted from 22 February to 4 March 2021 and the second internal assessment of Ed first and second year was conducted from 6 September to 17 September 2021.

Training work: - This year B.Ed. 1st and 2nd year students for training work on 3rd September for B.Ed. first year and 2nd year students on 27th July

Sent for training in the schools prescribed by the state government.

Examination Result- - The result of B.Ed. First year was 100 % and M.Ed. First year of the college was 83.33%. The result of B.Ed. second year was 98.44% and M.Ed. of the college was 100 %.

This year Sadhna Maurya, a B.Ed. student of the college, secured first position in the college and Kavita secured first position in M.Ed.

- **SEMINAR LECTURER AND WORKSHOP**

- **Pt. T. N. Mishra Memorial Lecture:** -

- First Pt. T.N. Mishra Memorial Lecture was organized at the Central Academy Teachers Training College on 5 September 2020. The Speaker was Dr. Sanat Kumar Arora, (Scientist, Former Head, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre and Visiting Professor, Centre for Excellence in Basic Sciences, Mumbai, Nuclear Physics and Nuclear Power of India). Taking the concepts of the program, he lectured on the subject, in this program both online and offline modes were taken, in which about 700 participants were participated. In this lecture, he explained completely from the basic concepts of physical science to the features of nuclear technology and its impact in India's technological development, the geopolitical aspects of nuclear science and its role in society and nation building.
- On December 23, 2020, on the occasion of the birthday of Late Pt.T.N. Mishra, the founder of Central Academy, an online celebrity lecture was organized under the founder Mr. Satish Kumar, Arora, (Scientist and former professor on crystallography, Sardar Patel Vishwavidyalaya Gujarat) as the keynote speaker in this program, he gave his lecture on the subject of "**Teacher of Tomorrow**", in which he discussed in detail about the future of the teacher and how the teacher should be in the future. If there are, then education of Indian culture, and values of life should be imparted in them.
- On November 2, 2020, the theme of Awareness Week was "Vigilant India, Prosperous India". Advocate Mr. Vivek Pareek was the main speaker in the lecture, he informed the examinees and lecturers about the "legal provisions related to prevention of corruption".
