A yoga camp was organized on 25th March 2025, in which yoga trainer Mrs. Saira Ahmed was invited to conduct the training session.



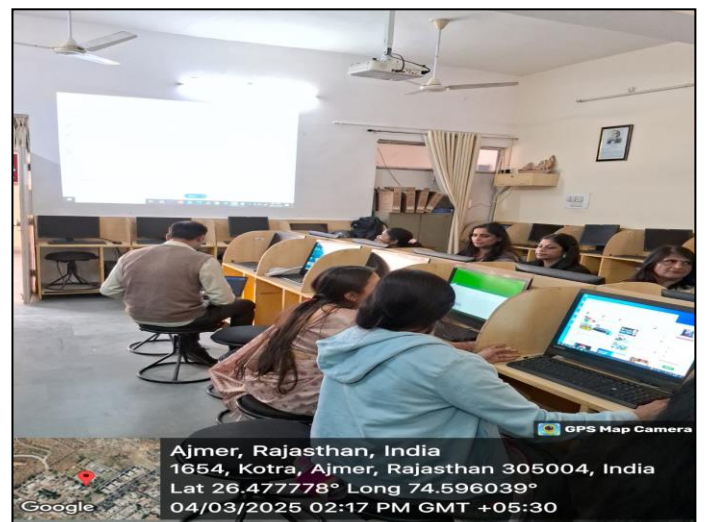
GROUP DISCUSSION

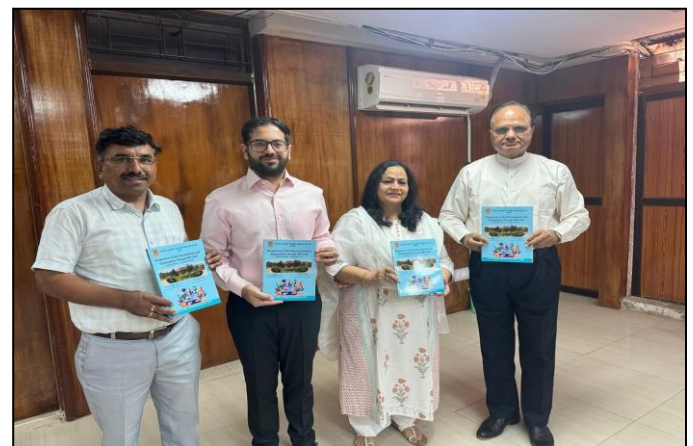
Dr. Taylor congratulated the winners and shared four key principles for success: goal-setting, hard work, passion, and self-confidence.
